UNITE CAMPAIGNING AGAINST THE SELL-OFF AND BREAK-UP OF OUR NHS

Unite members in the NHS have had enough. They are fed up with the mantra that says private companies and the competitive market are an efficient way of running public services and the NHS. Unite wants you to work together at a local level to challenge the policies that lead to vast amounts of public money being siphoned off into private companies rather than spent on patient care.

Unite is not prepared to see the NHS broken up and dismantled into a series of competing business units and privatised with the NHS being reduced to a logo.

It is estimated that the costs of managing the NHS market absorbs 20% of the NHS budget in England - amounting to approximately £20billion a year. Unite wants NHS staff, service users and the wider local community at a local level to work together to challenge the policies that will lead to large amounts of public money being siphoned off into private company profits rather than on delivering healthcare.

Unite believes the involvement of the private sector on such a widespread scale threatens to undermine the future of the NHS as we know it - a publicly accountable, nationally integrated, comprehensive health service.
